High Elevation Self-Rescue System

Should there be a need to self-rescue or rescue someone else from an elevated height, such as an inoperable bucket truck, the Buckingham 101SR makes it easy. The Buckingham 101SR provides all the components required to self-rescue or if the need arises to rescue a fellow employee. The 101SR descender will automatically stop the user until the user compresses the handle allowing a smooth controlled descent. An additional built in (anti-panic) safety feature stops descent if the user compresses the handle too hard. This unit will allow the rescuer the advantage of lowering a hurt person with ease as well. The 101SR kit comes with retrofit rappelling straps that can be added to an existing harness for self-rescue.

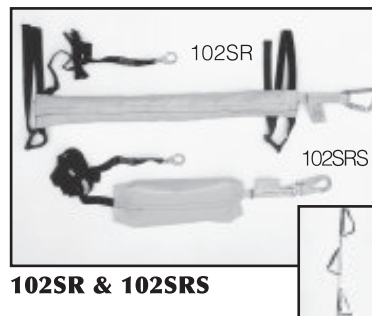

BuckStep Rescue Relief Step

Designed to alleviate the effects of orthostatic intolerance, also known as suspension trauma. Tests have proven that potentially fatal suspension trauma can occur within minutes of a fall. Since the typical rescue time is 15 minutes, the BuckStep allows a victim to immediately deploy a body support system that allows for improved blood circulation and the ability to move and flex muscles until rescue. Compact and easy to mount, the BuckStep attaches to any brand full body harness and is fully adjustable for any sized user.



102SR & 102SRS

After Fall Self-Rescue Ladder

102SR consists of a collapsible ladder packaged inside a TNX (vinyl coated) bag that mounts onto the boom or the fall arrest anchorage. The ladder will be pulled free should the user fall from the aerial basket. The ladder allows the user to climb back to safety. This is ideal for a troubleman working alone. The ladder extends up to 15 feet from the pack. The user connects the collapsible ladder to the harness using a small snap hook connected to a tag line.

102SRS - Same self-rescue features except it does not mount to the boom. the TNX pack is more compact and hangs from the anchor point.

Hurt Man Bucket Truck Rescue System

When a person is hurt and wedged in the bottom of the basket, retrieval is difficult. The 3813 bucket rescue is ideal to lift the hurt man easily and quickly. The pulleys are made of stainless steel with a 4 to 1 lifting advantage. It comes with 95' of 7/16" diameter rope that can support a load up to

1700 lbs. Designed to mount high to raise a person wearing a harness further up to ease the rescue. 3813D1 provides option to attach the 3813 unit to the boom strap dee ring quickly in an emergency.

3813 - Mounts to boom

3813D1 - Strap with dee ring mounts to boom allowing user to snap rescue system to dee ring when needed.
