5002MB Mar-Bar Ascending Kit with an Adjustable Bungee Tether Strap

The Mar-Bar Ascending Kit is used on a dual line (dynamic) system. Simply attach upper and lower Mar-Bars to climbing line, then attach the bungee tether to your saddle using a carabiner (not included). Put your feet in the lower Mar-Bar. Firmly grip the upper Mar-Bar with both hands and start your ascent. You can stop and rest by sitting in your saddle while attached to the upper Mar-Bar. Once you have reached your destination, secure yourself to the tree using a safety lanyard. Then disconnect one side of the upper and lower Mar-Bar from your climbing line, and lower them to the ground while pulling the working end of your climbing line up, then simply tie in with a traditional friction hitch, now you are free to work and descend as needed. The upper Mar-Bar can also be used by itself for a secured foot lock or body thrust without changing your set up. Elastic in the tether strap keeps it out of the way during your ascent by counteracting it approximately 40% of its total length. The tether is fully adjustable (18"-36") for your own personal preference.

5004HAS Handled Ascender Kit

The Handled Ascending Kit is used on a single line, and greatly reduces the energy needed on long climbs. Attach the upper and lower ascender to the climbing line, connect the steel ring to the suspension dee rings on the saddle using a carabiner (not included), put your feet in the nylon stirrups and start your ascent. Once you have reached your tie in point, secure yourself using a safety lanyard, disconnect your ascenders and tie in with a traditional friction hitch. Now you are free to move about the tree.

Rope Bags



4569PR2-150

A water resistant rope bag that will stand on its own. Large handles make it easy to carry and small pockets on the outside can be used to store carabiners and miscellaneous hardware. Extra stiff sides prevent the bag from collapsing when feeding rope into it. A heavy duty drawstring closure on the top keeps rope in and the weather out. Also ideal for storing throwline, throw bags, and other equipment.
